

The 12th Annual Coastline Children's Film Festival invites you to submit your short film (5 minutes or less) to the 2022 Young Filmmakers Competition. Entry is Free and open to anyone living in the U.S. (18 and under). Competition categories include Live Action/Narrative, Documentary and Animation. Films will be judged on creativity, originality and artistic/technical mastery. A one-hour program will be curated from all eligible submissions. Awards will be given to the top 3 films along with a Michigan's Best Award. In addition, an Audience Favorite Award will be presented to the entry that receives the most votes during the festival. Films completed between 2019-2022 are eligible.	Production, writing or directing with (or by) adults will not be considered.
Work alone or with friends (18 years or younger).	Entries are to be submitted via filmfreeway.com .
Limit one entry per person or group.	A one-hour program will be curated from all eligible submissions.
Running time: 5 minutes or less.	Awards include First, Second, Third, Audience Favorite & Michigan's Best.
No film trailers or pre-formatted templates.	Entry deadline is January 15, 2021. All juror decisions are final.
