Culture shock upon arrival gives way to fascination as she discovers the area's rich artistry and storytelling. New friends help Rosie uncover her connection to Iran, her inspiration, and her own artistic voice. Anne Marie Fleming adapted her own graphic novel to create a testament to the value of identity and the power of art to bridge languages, cultures and generations.
